East Sussex School Health Service (ESSH) and Children's Integrated Therapies and Equipment Service (ESCITES) recognise this is a challenging time for school staff, pupils and families. Coronavirus (COVID-19) may cause fear and anxiety, which can be overwhelming.

We would like to reassure you that both services will continue to provide care to those schools that are now closing and we are increasing the ways in which we can engage with children and families in the event of school closures and for families who are unwell or self-isolating.

ESCITES one point

A new central number for ESCITES will be in operation from Monday, 23 March. Please contact us on 0300 123 2650. This single point of access is a permanent change.

This is a single contact point for speech and language therapy, physiotherapy, occupational therapy – including adaptations – specialist equipment and general enquiries. This is specific advice for children on our caseload, as well as advice and/or support for children and young people not accessing our service.

Text your school nurse

Young people aged between 11 and 18 can access support from a qualified nurse by texting **07507 332473**. This is a confidential service available between 9am and 5pm, Monday to Friday. This service will be maintained through school closures and other service disruptions.
