


Hello, my name is Mrs Zoe Wenham and I am the new Attendance Officer at St Catherine's College. I have lived in Eastbourne all my life and enjoy spending quality family time with my husband and children. Additionally, I have been very fortunate to have

worked in education for 17 years and I am passionate about helping every child make progress and reach their God-given potential.

I would like to thank parents for their support in ensuring full attendance. Whole school attendance is well above 95% and approximately 800 pupils have recently received a chocolate bar for full attendance.

Did you know that if your child has an attendance rate of 95% that is **10 school days or 50 lessons missed**? An 80% attendance result is **40 days or 200 lessons missed**. Statistics show that students with an attendance rate of **less than 90%** have only a **35% chance of achieving five good GCSE passes including English and Maths**.



So far this year, we have set up the St Catherine's College Attendance Champions League and the 'In to Win' competition to encourage good school attendance. Both incentives have caused quite a buzz of excitement and inquisitiveness amongst the pupils; it is great to see them taking ownership of their attendance!
