We have been particularly impressed with how smart the pupils are looking in their college uniforms and I'd like to take this opportunity to thank parents for their ongoing support with this. A reminder that all shoes should be formal plain black leather (or leather type). In Years 7 to 10 either trousers embroidered with the school's initials or a tartan skirt must be worn. In Year 11 pupils are permitted to wear a plain black skirt or trousers. However, any skirts worn should not be shorter than 10cm from the middle of the knee. I would also like to take this opportunity to remind you about the importance of excellent school attendance. Pupils with an attendance rate of over 98% can average over half a grade of progress more than national expectations in all subjects. Every pupil should be aiming for 100% attendance; any school time missed places children at risk of falling behind. We have a new
